Les Misérables (French pronunciation: [le mizeʁabl(?)]) is a French historical novel by Victor Hugo, first published in 1862, that is considered one of the greatest novels of the 19th century. In the English-speaking world, the novel is usually referred to by its original French title. Thank you for this "blog" – the difference in time periods of the "Revolution" and Les Mis is very difficult to explain succinctly to people coming to our library wanting both historical fiction and non-fiction supporting this new movie. Napoleon planned many urban regeneration projects for Paris and was particularly fond of monuments to his victories. He wanted to create a significant triumphal structure to demonstrate his military prowess and began the process of designing a 24 m (78 ft) bronze elephant.
